This type of repair is generally faster too – often taking just one day to complete.

Trenchless Pipe Repair

Here's how it works:

- 1 DIG A HOLE AT EACH END OF THE PIPE.
- 2 FEED A PULLING CABLE THROUGH THE EXISTING PIPE.
- 3 CONNECT THE PULLING CABLE TO A BURSTING HEAD, WHICH IS ATTACHED TO THE NEW PIPE.
- PULL THE NEW PIPE THROUGH THE OLD PIPE. THE BURSTING HEAD WILL BREAK UP THE OLD PIPE TO CLEAR A PATH FOR THE NEW PIPE.
- 5 CONNECT THE NEW PIPE TO THE CITY WATER OR SEWER LINE, AND TO THE HOME.
